

Ooh and ahh at the winter wonderland scenes scattered throughout Downtown Milwaukee by hopping on the Jingle Bus, powered by KB Excursions.

This 40-minute narrated tour highlights the main attractions of the Milwaukee Holiday Lights Festival, including our four parks: "Community Spirit Park" at Cathedral Square Park, "Santa's Celebration Square powered by We Energies" at Zeidler Union Square, "¡Felices Fiestas!" at Pere Marquette Park, and "Slice of Ice Lights" at Red Arrow Park.



Jingle Bus tickets are \$8 per person and can be purchased at milwaukeeholidaylights.com. Guests can choose their tour date and time online, with an option to take a Spanish language tour on Sundays. Tickets may also be purchased on-site with cash.



This year, buses will depart from the Festival's new Warming House sponsored by Verizon at Red Arrow Park. Jingle Bus riders will receive a complimentary cocoa and cookie from Biggby Coffee and can enjoy ice skating before or after their tour once the Slice of Ice rink opens. Skate rentals are \$11 for adults and \$9 for children. Ice skating is free with your own skates.

Jingle Bus parking is available at the BMO Tower garage, 771 N. Broadway, for only \$3.24, thanks to Interstate Parking, Please see the Jingle Bus info table for parking validation.

Please note, the Jingle Bus will operate free from Pere Marquette Park on Kickoff night, Nov. 20. Jingle Bus service is weather permitting.
